Ojai Valley Gun Club National Match Report - May 2010 National Match Report

The May 2010, OVGC Highpower Rifle Match had ten shooters under sunny and warm conditions. There was a steady 10 knot wind throughout most of the contest that made things interesting. The contest was a "club event" 800 point - 80 round across-the-course ("XTC") match, with shots fired from distances of 200, 300 and 600s yards. Overall high score came from Robert Coffey, using a Match Rifle and scoring 755-15X. Second overall and high Service Rifle was shot by Mike Stern with a 733-8X. The warm sun and dry conditions made for a nice day of shooting and a good time was had by all.

The June 2010 match will be an NRA Approved 600 point – 60 round Medium Range course of fire, shot from the 600 yard line, open to OVGC members (\$10) and all non-members (\$20).

Coming up on the 4th of July will be a Special NRA Approved Garand/Springfield/ Vintage Match. Last year's July vintage match was well attended, including some notable names from the SoCal NRA Highpower shooting community, including Dennis DeMille and Gunny R. Lee Ermey, just to name a few.

Dust off that old service rifle (1903 Springfield, M1 Garand, M1A, AR15, etc.), or that "tricked out" match rifle and come up and join the National Match Highpower shooters for a fun day on the range. The matches are open to both members and non-members. New shooters or beginners in the highpower discipline are welcomed and encouraged. We hope to see you there. Look for detailed fliers with information on all matches, both "NRA Approved" and "club" events on the OVGC website, under "National Match". AP .30-06 M2 BALL: The .30-06 AP ammo that we now have available includes headstamps: AYR, SL, TW, and LC. Dates of manufacture vary from the 1940s to the 1950s. Most of the ammo is corrosive, but some may be non-corrosive. The ammo is packaged in 8 round M1 Garand enbloc clips, in bandoleers, in spam cans. Purchases of multiple cans will be shipped in what appear to be the original wooden crates (two spam cans per crate). Cans and crates will be selected luck of the draw as to the headstamp. 4C3006U202-192P. Single spam can (192 rounds). \$60.00. S&H at \$8.95 per can. CMP will not ship any AP ammo to Massachusetts, Washington D.C., Puerto Rico, or the Virgin Islands. The following states do have laws regarding AP ammo, but the laws are unclear as to whether or not they apply to .30-06 AP ammo, since this ammo was designed for use in a rifle and not in a handgun. Customers from these states should be aware that even though .30-06 AP may be currently sold in their states, there is a risk of arrest and prosecution for the possession of .30-06 AP, depending on how their local law enforcement officers interpret their state definition of "Armor Piercing or Restricted ammo". These states are: California, Illinois, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Michigan, Mississippi, Rhode Island, Tennessee, New York, New Jersey, Hawaii, and

Nevada. Residents of these and all other states should check your state and local laws on ammunition sales before ordering. Even in states where state law does not prohibit AP, there may be cities within that state that prohibit or restrict possession of AP ammo. BELTED .30-06 AMMO: CMP now has a small quantity of .30-06 belted ammo. M2 Ball, .30-06, Belted in 250 rd Ammo cloth belts, in .30 cal cans. Manufactured by Kynoch Works (British). 4C3006B200-250P. Corrosive primers. Manufactured 50-53. Weight 18 lbs per can. S&H per can - \$9.95. See the ammunition tab on Estore at <https://estore.odcmp.com>
