400 point aggregate, 40 rounds for record

This month's high power match was a hastily formulated 200 Yard Walk down Match shot all on the SR target, 5 sighters and 40 rounds for record. As our "Anniversary" match, we were confronted with the prospect of postponing the match due to the brush fire and resulting damage. Luckily, we improvised with garden stakes and placed the targets in front of the 200 yard berm. Our pit wall and catwalk were burned in the fire.

We had a turn out of 13 competitors and two coaches. Everyone pitched in to set up targets and the match was run in three relays. Firing was complete by 12:30 PM and all hands broke for Subway sandwiches that George Gaskill was kind enough to run out to pick up for the range. After lunch, the improvised system was removed from the berm and posts and targets were stowed for future use. A big thanks to all who attended for their adaptability. Thank you to coaches Frank Lopez and Dennis Santiago who came out and added their valuable guidance to the newer shooters. And thanks to Greg Sullivan for coming out to setup and support our efforts.
